Become a Museum Docent!

Learn how to lead tours in the Train Shed Exhibit Building, on the train, and at the Snoqualmie Depot. Docents are trained in historical interpretation and teaching methods, provided with a main theme and key points, and given information they can use to create and build fun and interesting tours.

Training consists of a 2 hour info session followed by four 3-4 hour training sessions on Saturdays in May and June. Docents are required to attend all sessions in order to complete the training* and qualify as Museum Docents. (*Trainees must complete a full tour on their own on a 5th day in order to fully qualify.)
